

EL PASO STORY SAFEST CITY IN THE US 2010-2012

El Paso clergy of all faiths agreed in 1995 to implement marriage mentor ministry within their individual congregations. Divorce plummeted 79.5% from 1996 – 2001 in their city.*

MARRIAGE MENTOR COUPLES

- Experienced, vitalized, and faithful couples
- Mentors walk along side another couple as equals
- They listen, encourage, & witness as role models



MARRIAGE MENTOR COUPLES

Everyday people <u>not</u> experts or therapists

- Mentors help couples build a house on rock & offer help along the way
- They offer empathy and information
- Mentors inspire couples to explore fresh possibilities



MARRIAGE MENTOR MINISTRY BUILD A HOUSE ON ROCK

- Couples take a customized premarital inventory that helps mentors *prepare* them
- Mentors *enrich* couples with relationship-building events (*e.g.* 10 Great Dates)



OFFER HELP ALONG THE WAY

- Help *restore* marriages in crisis with trained mentors whose own marriages once nearly failed
- Reconcile separated couples with mentors who help one spouse attract and win back the other
- Help Step-families succeed by creating a Stepfamily Support Group



FIVE MENTOR MINISTRIES

True Love For Married Couples

- **Prepare** engaged couples for marriage
- *Enrich* the married congregation
- **Restore** marriages in crisis
- Reconcile emotionally estranged & separated couples
- *Help Step-families* succeed by creating Stepfamily Support Groups



STARTING MENTOR MINISTRY

FIRST THINGS

- Present vision of mentoring & invite prospective married couples to meet at end of service
- Identify prospective leaders & mentor couples
- Schedule initial Prepare-Enrich & mentor couple training



STARTING MENTOR MINISTRY

WHO CAN BE A MENTOR COUPLE?

- Long-term married couples in vitalized marriages
- Couples that recovered from a struggling marriage
- Couples with divorce/annulment prior to healthy marriage



STARTING MENTOR MINISTRY

TIMELINE

- Invite couples & identify leaders ~ 2-4 wks
- Prepare-Enrich training for mentors ~ 6-8 hrs
- Marriage Mentor training ~ 6 hrs
- Begin mentoring ~ 2 couples/yr (minimum)
